Analyte description	Neutrophil gelatinase-associated lipocalin (NGAL) is a small glycoprotein expressed in the bone marrow, epithelial tissues associated with antimicrobial defense, and in the distal tubules and collecting duct of the kidney. Elevated levels of blood and urine NGAL are associated with acute or chronic renal failure.

Stability testing is performed in the product buffer to see whether different temperatures affect the antigen binding, charge or composition of the antibody. Please note that the shelf life given on the first page is based on real time stability testing at 2–8 °C in the product buffer.
